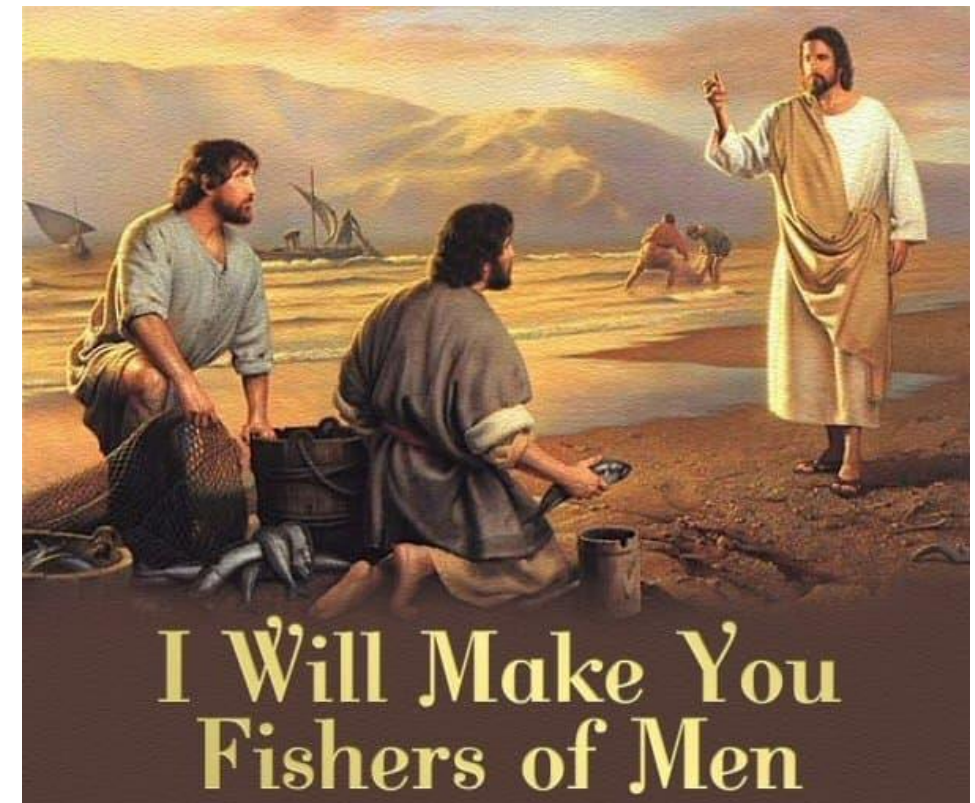
Copies of the minutes from the January Church Council meeting are in the rack near the Sanctuary doors, as well as copies of the newsletter.
