From the Pastor:

Dear Church Family,

The long awaited (for 6 years) UMC General Conference has completed its work and several controversial decisions were reached by majority vote. Following is a list of the most important changes to the United Methodist Book of Discipline:

- Bans on celebrating same-sex unions were deleted. New language was added stating, "Within the church, we affirm marriage as a sacred lifelong covenant that brings two people of faith, an adult man and woman of consenting age, or two adult persons of consenting age into union with one another..."
- A new paragraph, 340.3 was added declaring, "No clergy at any time may be required or compelled to perform, or be prohibited from performing, any marriage, union, or blessing of any couple, including same sex couples. All clergy have the right to exercise and preserve their conscience when requested to perform any marriage, union, or blessing of any couple."
- Conferences and churches are banned from discriminating against clergy based on sexual orientation. Paragraph 425.1 now says, "Open itineracy means appointments are made without regard to race, ethnicity, origin, gender, color, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or age, except for the provision of mandatory retirement." Annual Conferences are directed to train Pastor Parish Relations Committees to receive pastors regardless of sexual orientation.
- Clergy are no longer specifically required to be celibate if single and monogamous in male/female marriage. Along with homosexual behavior, these have been removed as chargeable offenses. Specific bans on adultery and sex before or outside marriage were removed. (continued on next page)

- Sweeping changes to the UMC Constitution were approved allowing UMC jurisdictions (regions of annual conferences) to organize as a region and adopt their own rules if ratified in the annual conferences. Global annual conferences can do likewise.
- Individual churches may choose not to recognize or affirm same sex marriage by a vote of the church trustees.
- The church disaffiliation legislation had a sunset clause of December 31, 2023. It was not renewed. Churches that wish to exit the UMC no longer have that pathway. However, the South Carolina and South Georgia conferences allow exiting Churches to utilize the Local Church Discernment Process grounded in Discipline Paragraph 2549. This paragraph is typically employed when a local church, after following the discernment process, determines the need to close. Unlike the disaffiliation process, the Local Church Discernment has no sunset clause. Certain financial obligations as calculated by conference trustees- will need to be satisfied (paid to the Conference) before a congregation can be approved to separate. These include a tithe equal to 10 percent of the appraised value of all church property and liquid assets, all unpaid apportionment giving for the prior year as well as the year of closure up to the date of Annual Conference, and an additional 12 months of apportionment giving.
- On abortion, a new resolution declares: "The United Methodist Church upholds a person's right to an abortion after informed consideration with their family, medical practitioners, pastor, and other pertinent counsel. State and federal laws and regulations prohibiting abortion violate a person's right to the full range of reproductive healthcare and, potentially life..."

These were some of the major legislative outcomes of the UMC 2024 General Conference held in Charlotte, N.C. April 23^{rd} – May 3^{rd} . The South Carolina Annual Conference will be processing these decisions when it meets June 9^{th} – 12^{th} . We have been asked to remain patient until everything has been worked out. We will set up a Charge/Churchwide meeting to discuss the outcome following Annual Conference. Plan to attend if you would like to join the discussion on these matters. In the meantime, let me know if you have any questions. I will answer as best I can.
